ISU Individualised Diploma: Students pursue course credits in individualised ISU courses in Career Prep and 1 student Life Skills (Not equivalent to a US HS Diploma). 

IB DP Points Distribution - Class of 2024

















Creativity, Activity, Service Program (CAS)


As an IB World School, ISU requires all Grade 11 and 12 students to participate in the CAS Program as an extension of their academics regardless of their diploma pathway. Students have the opportunity to participate in sports, the arts, and STEAM competitions internationally through the International Schools of Southern and Eastern Africa (ISSEA) league as well as competing in a smaller, local league. There are a range of after-school activities offered, including the Global Citizens Diploma, Duke Of Edinburgh, Model United Nations, Student Council, and other academic and non-academic activities. Service opportunities are offered as well, which take place on the school campus and in the local community.
